- Academic Staff Governance
 - Rights are codified in State Statute (University Staff rights are a Board of Regents Policy)
 - Campus View vs. College/Division/Dept View
- Academic Staff Assembly (ASA)
 - Meet the 2nd Monday of the month
 - Largest group on campus (132 districts; ~30 unrepresented)
 - Executive Committee (ASEC) consists of 9 members (meets weekly)

- <4000 staff on campus (lower numbers since TTC)
- Promote shared governance
- Meet the 3rd Monday of the month (in Bascom Hall)
- Largest group is the Congress; public comments at meetings; 1-year terms; 6 committees
- Vice Chancellor attends
